CNADM Convention Information

We will attend the Chicago National Association of Dance Masters (CNADM) in Oakbrook, IL (Doubletree Hotel) on Saturday, November 4th and Sunday, November 5th. Dancers will attend classes from appx. 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m. on Saturday and from 9 a.m.-3:30 p.m. on Sunday with an hour lunch break each day. The performance on Saturday evening will take place at 6:00 p.m. Admission to the performance is free, but no videotaping or photography is allowed.

Older dancers will have the opportunity to participate in a college fair along with some educational sessions on careers in dance whether that be the academic route or straight to professional. Awesome opportunity!!

The convention fee is due September 25th and should be made payable to Elation Dance Center. Convention fee: \$275. I also need a copy of everyone's birth certificate. (If you gave me one in the past I do not need another.)

This rate is available until October 5th or when all the rooms are sold out. They run out of double rooms very fast, so book early! You are welcome to book elsewhere if you like or need.
